

Moscow (artist) on the Hudson

he Progressive Art Gallery is the temporary home for works by Alla, an artist whose roots are in Moscow but whose oeuvre is international in scope. Through Thursday, the exhibit of her paintings, pen-and-ink drawings and prints calls attention to her various styles. There are remembrances of Paris, where she spent nine years ("Tango," left, is from that period), and Russia (collages of her grandmother with mementos of times gone by).

Now Alla lives in New York, and her various cityscapes — "The Brewery," above, and "Manhattan Fog" — offer another viewpoint by this young artist whose only boundary is her imagination.
